

Peter Fajfar is Professor Emeritus at the University of Ljubljana. His main research interest is seismic analysis and design of structures. He was a visiting professor at several renowned universities, including Stanford University. In the period 2003-2015 he was one of three Editors of the journal *Earthquake Engineering and Structural Dynamics*. He served on the Board of Directors of the International Association of Earthquake Engineering and was a member of the Executive Committee of the European Association of Earthquake Engineering. In both associations he was elected an Honorary Member. He has been involved in the development of the European standard Eurocode 8 and led the implementation of this standard in Slovenia, which was the first country where Eurocode 8 became compulsory. As a designer, consultant and/or reviewer, he has participated in a large number of projects for industry. He received several awards, among them the highest award for the scientific work in Slovenia and Prof. Nicholas Ambraseys Distinguished Lecture Award. Fajfar is a member of the Slovenian Academy of Sciences and Arts, of the Slovenian Academy of Engineering, of the European Academy of Sciences (Belgium), and of the National Academy of Engineering (USA).
